The user is informed that cookies may be automatically installed in your browser software when visiting a website.

You have the right to access, modify, delete or transfer the data, and to limit or object to the processing of the data, by sending a letter or by writing to Symbio [Adresse postale du délégué à la protection des données]. ## 4 : Information about cookies

### Définition

When the user visits the site [www.symbio.one](http://www.symbio.one), he can install cookies on his terminal, depending on the choices and options set in his browser.

A cookie is a file that is stored on the user's device. They perform many functions: they allow the user to save browser settings, collect statistics, authorize specific technical functions, etc.

Symbio uses cookies to facilitate navigation, including storing information that will be used the next time the user accesses the site.

### Purposes

The main purposes of the cookies installed on the Symbio website are :

- Technical cookies: strictly necessary to provide an online communication service expressly requested by the user (session identifier, authentication).
- Audience measurement cookies: used to produce statistics and analyses of the number of visitors of the website.
- Cookies from partner services (video) allowing them to know the uses of their platform and to display, if necessary, targeted advertisements.

When a visitor visits our site, information is collected for statistical purposes about his or her connection and behavior (number of visitors, pages visited). This information does not allow Symbio to directly identify the visitor and the site editors do not take any steps to identify the visitor; in particular, there is no cross-referencing or agreement between the personal information requested by the user in the form and the information needed for statistical purposes.

Symbio uses the analytical tool provided by Google Inc. called Google Analytics, which allow to analyze the use of the site and more generally to compile reports and track activity on the pages of the site. The user is informed that the data generated by these cookies are therefore accessible to the company Google Inc. and are transferred to its servers in the United States. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or to its subcontractors and contractual partners. Users may choose to permanently disable the above cookies or configure their browser to warn them before saving them on their computer and present each cookie for approval at any time.

It is important for the User to know that deactivating cookies may prevent him or her from taking advantage of some of the services offered by the Site and therefore affect the smoothness of his or her navigation, for which Symbio cannot be held responsible. Symbio therefore advises to filter cookies according to their purpose, rather than deactivating them all together.
